When you eat something salty, the salt crystals dissociate into the component ions Na^+ and Cl^- , which dissolve into the saliva in your mouth. The Na^+ concentration becomes high outside the gustatory cells, creating a strong concentration gradient that drives the diffusion of the ion into the cells.
